

TERMS AND CONDITIONS SHEET FOR ROAD OCCUPANCY PERMITS

The terms and conditions embodied in this permit require the permittee to complete this work by the date specified in the permit. Escrow funds will be held in a non-interest bearing account.

Neither the issuance of this permit, the payment and receipt of the permit or inspection fees in connection therewith, nor the description and purpose of the work as well as any requirements, set forth therein shall, under any circumstances, be construed as any assumption by the Township either of any responsibility for any defects in the work performed under or pursuant to this permit or of any responsibility or liability for damages resulting from this installation; but all such responsibility and liability is understood to rest solely upon the permittee.

Where permittee fails to comply with the conditions as to completion of the work by the time specified, the following rules will govern:

- a) Failure to start work by date specified for completion. Permit will be cancelled unless permittee desires an extension of time, in which case a supplemental permit may be issued by the Township Road Engineer, subject to payment of an additional fee of \$10.00.
- b) Work started and not completed by specified date. Permittee will notify the Township Road Engineer, prior to expiration of allotted time, of inability to complete the work on or before the date specified and request an extension of time. Such request shall be accompanied by a fee of \$10.00, and if approved, a Supplemental Highway Permit will be issued.
- c) Permittee not desirous of carrying out proposed work on account of change in conditions affecting it. Permittee will notify the Township Road Engineer, previous to the date specified for completion, that work will not be carried forward, returning the permit with such notice. A fee of \$10.00 will be charged for the cancelled permit. The remainder of the issuance fee will be refunded to the permittee or credited on another permit as requested by the permittee. The fee for inspection of the work will be refunded.

The fees to be paid under the conditions outlined in (a), (b), and (c) apply only to permits for which fees are collected in accordance with the fixed schedule.

All notices relative to time extensions or cancellations shall be forwarded to the Township Road Engineer which issued the original permit.

Important

All fees for permits, supplemental permits, renewals, extensions, or cancellations hereof shall be made payable to North Coventry Township. All fees for inspecting additional work or for restoring the improved surface shall be made payable to North Coventry Township.
